



Chania City Tour on 22/5 **Departure from hotels or MAICH at 14:00**

The City Tour of Hania, consists of a full tour in the history and variousness of Hania. Starting from the Old Port, which is a meeting spot of different cultures, the visitor can admire the old Venetian fortress "Firkas"(housing the Naval Museum), as well as the numerous oriental rhythm buildings, which were constructed during the occupation of Turks. Visitor will be "captured" by the monuments, the ottoman precinct "Giali Tzami", the famous dockyards, the marvellous street of knives-craftsmen and the Venetian pearl barley of Hania, which is a terrific tourist trap.

As the tour moves on, the visitor can enjoy browsing in the public market, built in 1911 and containing numerous of different shops and to the archeological museum.

The tour ends with the transfer to the famous "Venizelos Graves" where visitor can admire a spectacular view of the city.

A day of discovery to the Palace of [Knossos](#) and the 4000 year old relics of a Minoan civilisation redeemed almost to its former glory. The myths and legends from the era that gave us plumbing and air-conditioning, long before civilisation as we know it was even thought of, will fascinate you.

The fabulous Minoan Palace of Knossos, once the residence of the legendary King Minos, stands loftily on a hill. In its heyday it must have been an impressive sight with its splendid architecture, monumental staircases and beautiful frescoes. Whilst leading you through the palace chambers, halls and courtyards, our professional guide will paint the picture in your mind, of 4000 years of mystery and history.

The excursion continues with a visit to [Herakleio](#), the capital of Crete, with an opportunity to wander through the busy streets, to window shop, see the market, or have lunch in one of the many tavernas, or in a café by the square. (Approx 1 – 1.5 hours time for shopping)

Then, off to the museum, where you will see the treasures and authentic frescoes, retrieved from Knossos during the excavations by the English archaeologist, Sir Arthur Evans, along with the superb collection of pottery, stone, carvings and gold jewellery.

A truly fascinating day, Knossos is a must for every visitor to Crete.
