English in Academic Purposes (EAP) courses - Diploma in English for Academic Purposes /Extended English Course / 11, 8 and 5 week Pre-sessional English Courses

Students wanting to improve their academic English for future academic study at UCL or other universities are welcome to apply for EAP courses at UCL, but for the 11, 8 and 5 week Pre-sessional Courses only applicants holding a conditional offer for a UCL degree programme will be considered.

To calculate the shortest course we will offer you a place on, you need to know the English language level required for the degree course you eventually want to study on, as well as an IELTS or IBT TOEFL qualification.

You can apply for a longer course than the one indicated in the guidance, but you won't be offered a place on a course unless you meet the minimum levels required.

When you apply online you will be asked to upload a valid English language qualification if you have one. For the 11, 8 and 5 week Pre-sessional courses you must upload a UCL degree course offer to be considered.

Once you've completed the application form and uploaded the relevant documents you will be directed to UCL's Online Store where you will need to pay the course application fee of £50 by credit or debit card.

Your application and payment confirmation will come directly to UCL's Centre for Languages & International Education. We will then contact you to confirm if we can offer you a place on the course or if we need other documents from you. This will normally take a few days, but when we are very busy it may take up to 10 working days. If we offer you a place on one of our courses, we will email you a formal offer letter explaining how to pay the course fees, with additional information about UCL accommodation and applying for a visa if you need one to study in the UK. A Confirmation of Acceptance for Studies (CAS) that can be used for a visa application will normally be sent to you approximately 3 months before your course starts.
