## Map 2: Park Crescent Conference Centre

**Address:** 229 Great Portland Street, W1W 5PN

**Directions:** The Centre, also known as International Students House, is approximately a 10-15 minute walk from the Bloomsbury Campus along Euston Road towards Regent's Park. It is situated at the top of Great Portland Street directly opposite Great Portland Street Station.

**Tube lines:** Nearest tube stations are Great Portland Street (Circle, Hammersmith & City and Metropolitan lines) and Regent's Park (Bakerloo line).

**Bus services:** C2, 18, 27, 30, 88, 205 and 453.
