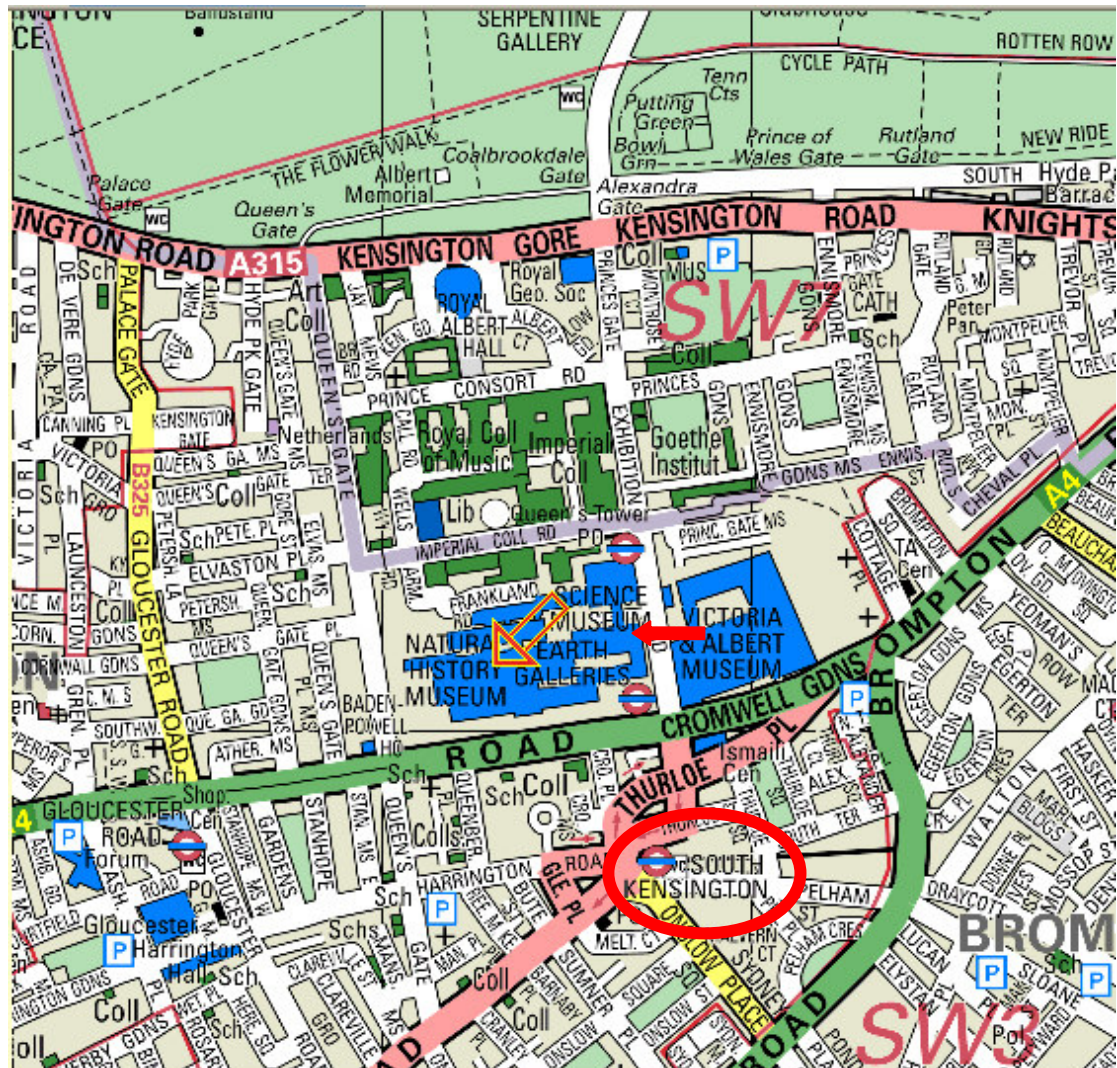


## Darwin's Birthday Party Lectures Finding the Natural History Museum's Exhibition Road Entrance and the Flett Lecture Theatre



The nearest tube stop is South Kensington on the District, Circle and Piccadilly lines. After you leave the turnstiles, turn sharply right and go under the streets through the tunnel, leave at the exit marked Natural History Museum and at street level turn left and go north (towards the park) until you come to the big flag with a letter N on it which marks the Exhibition Road entrance – staff there can direct you to the Flett Theatre (it is essentially right above the Exhibition Road entrance).

Security at the public entrances to the NHM is tighter than in the past, so please be sure to leave plenty of time to have your bags searched, and don't bring any sharp objects! Also please do not check your coat, as you will be unable to retrieve it after the event itself.

On the map South Kensington Station is circled in red and the Exhibition Road entrance is marked with a red solid arrow; the other arrow marks the Museum, you can't miss it – it is a huge building!
