

## Longview

Longitudinal and Life Course Studies (LLCS) is a new peer-reviewed, on-line journal, that offers longitudinal researchers from across the world, a new opportunity for publication of substantial papers (up to 7000 words) in the field of life course studies. The journal is free for authors, and free to download. Its aim is to facilitate communication and understanding of longitudinal research findings, and of methodological developments in research and policy communities, as widely as possible. The development phase of LLCS is being supported by a 3-year grant from the Nuffield Foundation.

LLCS will be of interest internationally to academics and policy makers working at the interface of social, developmental and health science, including psychology, education, epidemiology, genetics, sociology, economics, demography, geography, criminology, political science, policy studies, history and statistics. It will also appeal to those concerned with all types of methodological development of relevance to life course and longitudinal research.

LLCS will also include news about developments in longitudinal research resources, opportunities in research, conferences and other events of interest to an international readership, and book reviews in due course.

The Journal Editors seek original papers for any of the *LLCS* sections, and cross-cutting papers embracing more than one of them. Guidance for authors on the submission of papers and other contributions is available on the Journal's website <a href="https://www.journal.longviewuk.com">www.journal.longviewuk.com</a> together with self-registration details.

**The first issue of** *LLCS* will be published in April 2009, with the closing date for submissions of 30 Nov 2008. The second issue will appear in October 2009, with a submissions closing date of 30th April 2009. Issues will appear quarterly from January 2010.

**Examples of papers** submitted for the first issue include:

- Family communications and financial independence
- Bladder control and maturational level, temperament and maternal psychopathology
- Maternal employment in the preschool years and children's later development
- Anti-social behaviour and mortality
- Handling attrition and non-response in longitudinal surveys
