

Registration Details for Various Departments 2011/2012

Economics

Places are allocated on a first-come, first-served basis in this Department – and priority is given to students in Economics and the related degrees within UCL until 5pm Wednesday 28th September - if there is subsequent space on the module you will be signed up accordingly. Economics cannot guarantee that you will be successful but, having said that, they make every effort to enrol all students who wish to take their modules. However, due to limited resources and popularity of modules (e.g. 7003: Money and Banking). Note is also taken of previous attendance records and examination results, particularly where students have studied in this Department before.

Returning SEF students: If you need to discuss your choice of option, (Dr Rosen) will have designated office hours for this purpose during Registration Week (and this will be displayed on Economics website – likely to be Thursday 29th Sep from 1-3pm and Tuesday 4th and Thursday 6th Oct from 3-4pm). In the meantime you should consult the relevant webpages for information regarding pre-requisites in the first instance.

It is not necessary for students to register over here in person, you should just sign up on PORTICO and then check periodically to see if your selection has been approved or not. Tutorial classes will be allocated automatically by the College Timetabling system – CMIS and you will be able to access your personal timetable online for details of time and location, when advised.

Language Centre
