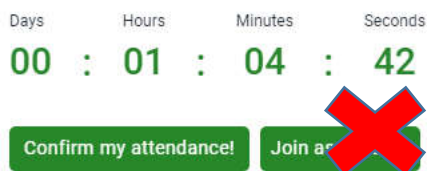


Joining a remo.co event – all participants

**** Make sure that the e-mail you used to register for the conference is the same one you use to register with remo.co ****

We've set up a series of events in remo.co - you'll find all the links below. Once you've registered on the remo.co platform (see above), just click on the link for any session you want to attend, and you'll see an option to confirm your attendance, similar to this:



Don't select 'JOIN AS SPEAKER' even if you are a speaker or a session chair

NB – even if you're a speaker or session chair, just click on 'Confirm my attendance' (we'll set you up as a speaker once you're in the event).

Assuming you've got a ticket for the event (either purchased via UCL or allocated by us as you're a speaker, sponsor or guest) then once you've confirmed, you'll be given an option to add the event to your diary, and the event will appear in your 'Joined Events' list (accessible from the remo.co menu at the top left). You can then join the event when it starts.

Notes

1. **Make sure that the e-mail you used to register for the conference is the same one you use to register with remo.co** – if this is not the case let us know and we'll update our e-mail list.
2. **You can drop in and out of an event at any time.**
3. Networking happens in 5 hour slots as this is the maximum length of a remo.co session – at change over time, you can just jump from one networking session to the next one ...
4. We'll circulate the links to the events via e-mail and will post them on <https://ucl.ac.uk/3dgeoinfo>
5. To make things slightly simpler (so that you don't have to sign up to too many small events), we've grouped the sessions into pairs.
6. There will be a separate list of links for the 'repeat' events for those in different time-zones – you can sign up for the events that best fit your availability
7. Sessions will start slightly before the scheduled time and end slightly after, to allow for testing of speakers and microphones for the presenters, and also for any overruns.

NB: Once you've confirmed your attendance at any event it will then appear on your "Joined Events" list – you only need to click the URL and confirm attendance once.
