The following regulations apply to students enrolled on undergraduate programmes in the Faculty of Social and Historical Sciences at UCL **in addition to** the main taught programme regulations detailed in the UCL Academic Manual and in particular in Chapter 1: Admissions, Registration and Student Conduct and Chapter 4: Assessment Framework for Taught Programmes.

Variations for the Award of an Honours Degree

1.1 Consideration for the Award of an Honours Degree

- 1. For the first year of study, only the best course unit (or two half-units) or one nominated course unit (or two half-units), determined in advance in accordance with local rules, will be included in the degree classification calculations.
- 2. For the second year of study, all four course units will be included in the degree classification calculations.
- 3. Degree classifications are calculated on the basis of the median of weighted course unit marks.
