



About the Speaker: Susanna Berger is Associate Professor of Art History and Philosophy at the University of Southern California. She received her B.A. from Columbia University (2007) and her M.Phil. and Ph.D. from the University of Cambridge (2012). From 2013 until 2016 she was a member of the Society of Fellows at Princeton University. Her first book, *The Art of Philosophy: Visual Thinking in Europe from the Late Renaissance to the Early Enlightenment* (Princeton University Press, 2017) was awarded the 2018 Bainton Prize from the Sixteenth-Century Society and Conference for the best book in art and music history.
