Application Preparation Advice

To process your application, the following guidance is instrumental for your application.

1) A statement to explain specifically what you know about the ***MSc Space Syntax: Architecture and Cities programme***, for what reasons you are applying, and what strengths you think you have which make you suitable for this programme.

2) A 1500-word essay on the following topic:

The relationship between spatial hierarchies with social interactions in the built environment.

In this essay, you will need to reference at least five relevant sources within the field of research. Additionally, it is required that you share personal experiences or reflections that are unique to you. These references may be drawn from your previous studies or work experience. Please be aware that the use of AI or chatbots for generating this essay is strictly prohibited, and if any such usage is detected, the essay will be disqualified.

Academic Group work is accepted but it needs to be clearly indicated.

Group work needs to be marked to indicate what your role was in the project.

Missing indication might result in rejection.

Applicants should upload their essay following the guidance above at the point of application wherever possible. To do so, please follow the instructions below:
