- 2. Draw/sketch/render/collage an illustration of your vision statement (one A4 page in portrait or landscape format). You can make use of any preferred media that enables you to convey the form, scale, location, etc of your vision.
- 3. Provide a complete portfolio of your design work. Please submit a weblink to an online portfolio set up (one A4 page in landscape or portrait format) hosted on ISSUU or a website address. If you wish to show a film please send the link to a Vimeo/Youtube account.

Academic Group work is accepted but it needs to be clearly indicated. Group work needs to be marked to indicate what your role was in the project. Missing indication might result in rejection.

Applicants should upload their work following the guidance above at the point of application wherever possible. To do so, please follow the instructions below:

Please upload a word document which includes your name, vision statement and illustration, and a link to your online portfolio, to the 'additional document' option in the supporting material section of the online application system.
