
Creating a graph or chart using **Illustrator**




Creating a graph using Illustrator


Make graphs: Pie graph, column graph, bar graph, etc.

Illustrator is very good to greate simple graphs staring from data.







- If you choose the 'pie graph tool',
 drag a selection to define the
 dimension of your graph (no worries,
 you'll be able to amend and resize it
 later).
- A table will automatically appear > ad here your data > apply.
- Now, your graph is created, and you
 can decide to close the table, or put it
 a side if you think you'll need to
 update the graph later.



To modify the appearance of the graph:

 Use the Direct Selection Tool > click on one slice of the pie > on the top bar, open the 'Recolor Artwork' window






To modify the appearance of the graph:


- Click on 'Advance Options' at the bottom of the Recolor Artwork window.
- To 'unlock colours', move randomly the colour bars
 HSB
- Now, the colours are realised.



To modify the appearance of the graph:

 Now, the colours are realised, and you can (1) click on the arrow to preview the colour on you graph, or (2) double click on the color box to edit colour.
