PLEASE <u>READ</u> AND FOLLOW THE INSTRUCTION STEP BY STEP!!

The process is long but straightforward if you follow each step. Once you make a mistake and install the wrong version/without a proper licence it will be very time consuming – and frustrating! – to set things right.

Before you start...

Before installing any Adobe software, ensure that you have <u>obtained the FREE Bartlett student license</u> and have <u>removed any Adobe trial software</u>.

Let's begin: requesting a FREE Adobe CC license

1. Visit <u>https://softwarehub.ucl.ac.uk/</u> and log in with your UCL userid email address and password

After you have obtained a free licence and set up your Adobe Creative Cloud account you will be able to access it even when you are not connected to the UCL network.

2. Once logged in the UCL Software Hub <u>https://softwarehub.ucl.ac.uk/</u> look for **Bartlett Adobe Creative Cloud** and click on Add.

PLEASE NOTE: Make sure to search for "Bartlett Adobe Creative Cloud" and not simply for Adobe Creative Clour	d.


Next Step: Accessing the Adobe Creative Cloud Suite for the first time

You can do this even if you are not connected to the UCL network.


You can decide if to install the Creative Cloud App for quicker access to your account and all the software downloads but this is not necessary in order to download the software.




Final Step: How to install Adobe CC software (Photoshop, InDesign, Illustrator, etc.)

You do not need to download the Creative Cloud App to download the individual software. You can simply access your Creative Cloud Account on your browser by following these steps:


