Note: RTPI accreditation requires you to have completed <u>either</u> a combination of 'spatial' and 'specialist' degrees (i.e. an accredited bachelors, giving the spatial element, plus at least an accredited diploma, giving the specialist element) <u>or</u> a 'combined degree', sometimes described as a 'stand-alone', 1-year MSc programme. The matrix above describes the routes available at BSP. On completion of your chosen route, you will be eligible for 'licentiate' membership of the RTPI.

\* - The UR and IREP programmes are only counted as combined degrees  $\underline{if}$  students pick either the modules BENVGPL5 or BENVGPL6  $\underline{and}$  BENVGTC1 as their electives.
