Topic: The Transform of Rural Planning and Governance in Metropolitan Areas: A Case of Jiangning, Nanjing

Speaker: Dr. Hui QIAN, Nanjing University

Abstract: This research studies the evolving process of planning practice since 2010 in Jiangning district, the best suburban district of Nanjing, one of the metropolitan city in Yangtze river delta. It also investigates the various types of governance modes in rural planning and development via the research on the making and delivery process of rural planning.

Topic: Strategic Plan for Fuzhou's State-level New Zone

Speaker: Dr. Yang ZHOU, Nanjing University

Abstract: Fuzhou's State-level New Zone is recently identified by the National government. As a pilot area for comprehensive development in the New Normal Era, the New Zone is expected to launch a package of systematic policies to realise New Type of Urbanisation in China which necessitate a strategic plan. Using a holistic approach, the Plan emphasizes both the ideal vision of the area for the future and the paths leading to the vision, both rigidity and flexibility, etc.
