Rethinking Capitalism

Rethinking Capitalism will introduce different economic perspectives and ways to tackle the grand challenges of the 21st century, from widening inequality to the climate crisis. It will encourage students to develop critical thinking skills and make connections between economic theory and real-world policy issues.

The module is based on the textbook *Rethinking Capitalism*, edited by professors Mariana Mazzucato and Michael Jacobs. The module will also feature guest lectures from leading economics thinkers and presentations by policymakers working at the frontline of the issues under discussion.

The module does not require formal training in economics or any other quantitative or technical skills.
