## The Faculty Impact Lead is an enabling role that:

- Supports the Faculty in its development of impact related activities
- Supports colleagues in their diverse approaches to impact
- Takes on any reasonable duties as requested by the Dean

## Within The Bartlett, the Faculty Impact Lead:

- Provides thought-leadership for impact, engaging with and leading academic conversations about impact, and the Faculty's relationship to this agenda
- Works closely with the Dean and other Vice Deans and faculty leads
- Works with the Faculty Impact Manager to establish and maintain impact support for colleagues, contributing to the Faculty Impact initiatives and communications
- Collaborates across the Faculty to ensure that The Bartlett is at the forefront of impact development at UCL and beyond
- Supports the development of research staff and early career academics in their impact plans
- Maintains productive relationships with key faculty staff (e.g. Director of Operations, Research and Enterprise Manager, and Research and Impact Data Analyst) and Directors/Heads of Departments
- Promotes multiple and inclusive definitions of impact, with a focus on reflection, evaluation, and partnership work
- Works with the Faculty Impact Manager to provide regular updates on progress to Research Advisory Group (RAG)
