



# **Quiet Contemplation Room**



Very few Unions have a volunteering team with as many opportunities as ours. There is an incredible level of support for volunteers, with every kind of project you could think of and even the chance to start your own.



# 26 Bedford Way

26 Bedford Way houses UCL Psychology and the UCL Centre for Languages & International Education. To get there:

- Leave UCL from the Malet Place exit (65), and turn left.
- Continue along Byng Place and Gordon Square, crossing over at the zebra crossing.
- Bedford Way will be on your right after a short walk; 26 Bedford Way is on the corner of Bedford Way and Gordon Square.

# Campbell House (East and West)

Campbell House is a self-catered hall, located at 5–10 Taviton Street, that is open today for self-quided tours. To get there:

- Leave UCL through the Malet Place exit
   (05), and turn left.
- Continue along Byng Place and Gordon Square, and take the second left turning onto Gordon Square (walking towards Taviton Street)
- Continue along Gordon Square, and up Taviton Street, until you reach Campbell House (East and West). Each house will be on your right and left respectively.

# John Dodgson House

John Dodgson House, providing self-catered accommodation, is open for self-guided tours today, and is about a 15-minute walk from UCL. It can be found at 24–36 Bidborough Street.

### To get there:

- 1. Head to the Green Zone and leave UCL through the Gower Street exit (②).
- Turn right onto Gower Street and continue until you reach Euston Road.
- Turn right onto Euston Road and continue until you see Mabledon Place on your right.
- Go down Mabledon Place, and take the first left onto Bidborough Street. John Dodgson House will be on your left.

# John Adams Hall

John Adams Hall is a self-catered hall that is open today for self-guided tours. To get there:

- 1. Leave UCL through the Malet Place exit (5), and turn left into Byng Place.
- 2. Continue along Byng Place and Gordon Square, and take the third left turning onto Tavistock Square (walking towards Endsleigh Gardens)
- Continue along Tavistock Square, and up Endsleigh Gardens, until you reach John Adams Hall on your left.

# **UCL** Institute of Education

For talks taking place in the UCL Institute of Education:

- 1. Leave UCL through the Malet Place exit (65), and turn left into Byng Place.
- Continue along Byng Place and Gordon Square, crossing over at the zebra crossing.
- 3. Bedford Way will be on your right after a short walk.
- The UCL Institute of Education, located at 20 Bedford Way is on your right, towards the end of the street.

# Student Central

For talks taking place in Student Central:

- Leave UCL through the Malet Place exit (cs), and turn left.
- 2. Cross the road at the zebra crossing and turn right.
- 3. Take the first left into Malet Street, Student Central is on your left.

# **Chandler House**

Chandler House is home to UCL Psychology and Language Sciences, located at Wakefield Street. It is about a 15-minute walk from the main campus. To get there:


- Leave UCL through the Malet Place exit
   (5), and turn left into Byng Place.
- 2. Continue along Byng Place and Gordon Square.
- Continue walking straight as the road becomes Tavistock Square and then, Tavistock Place.
- 4. At the junction with Marchmont Street, continue walking along Tavistock Place
- Following the junction with Judd Street/ Hunter Street, take the first right into Wakefield Street. Chandler House will be on your right.
