NSS Results 2020

- UCL Neuroscience BSc
 - Overall satisfaction 94%
 - Teaching on my course 92%

UCL Graduate Outcomes Survey 2017/2018 – Neuroscience BSc

Students are surveyed 15 months after graduation

- UCL Neuroscience Median Salary: £28,000
- In graduate level work or study: 100%

 - IT, Technology & Telecommunications: 20%
 - PR, advertising and marketing: 20%

Students are surveyed 15 months after graduation

- UCL Neuroscience Msci Median Salary: £27,000
- In graduate level work or study: 75%
- Key Industries Employing UCL Neuroscience MSci graduates:
 - Consultancy 25%
 - Energy, natural resources and the Environment 25%
 - Hospitality, Leisure and Tourism 25%
- Employers include Bulb Energy, Fishawack Communications and IP Pragmatics

80% of graduates are based in the UK and 20% in the European Union
