

Register for myUCLCareers email updates about events and work opportunities in sectors which may interest you

-  Make sure you are aware of **timelines** for applications, as some schemes/programmes require applications a year in advance
-  Use your **network** (family, peers, staff, alumni community, LinkedIn) to find or create opportunities
-  Learn more about **careers paths**, common obstacles and how to overcome them by asking graduates
-  Test it out by finding **work experience** and internships
-  Complete the 'Sourcing jobs and work experience' **Moodle course** to understand different tactics
-  Attend sector specific events to **network** with professionals and find out more about roles and routes into the sector



After your course ends...

-  Consider what will make the **transition** to this new life more comfortable, and then take the necessary steps
-  Identify your learning objectives and **develop a plan** to achieve them
-  Establish **supportive relationships**, join or create a professional network to help you achieve these goals
