By submitting your abstract, you are confirming that, if your abstract is accepted, you will prepare and submit a poster for the deadlines provided, and will register for and will attend the conference on both days.

whichever is earlier (there will no extensions)

	The presenting author of the abstract must register for the conference and must be eligible for conference attendance (please check before submission).
	Abstracts must be written in English.
	The person submitting the abstract must be the person with whom we should correspond about the abstract. This person is responsible for liaison with co-authors.
	Submitters will be notified by email if their abstract has been accepted. Please check all inboxes.
	All abstracts should be fully checked before submission. We reserve the right to correct spelling / typographical errors in the abstracts.
	All abstracts will be made available for online viewing to registered delegates of the conference up to fo days in advance of attending the event, and may also be made available online for up to three weeks aft the event. By submitting your abstract, you are agreeing to the above.
	Accepted abstracts will either be selected to be 15 minute platform presentations, 5 minute flash poster presentations with three slides or online poster presentations (poster format will be 3 PowerPoint slides
	If your abstract is accepted and you do not provide your finalised poster in accordance with any deadline specified, we reserve the right to remove your abstract / poster from the event.
