Abstract Submission Instructions

The Neuromuscular Translational Research Conference welcomes the submission of abstracts relating to neuromuscular diseases. Accepted abstracts will be selected for either oral platform, oral flash poster, or poster presentations.

By submitting your abstract, you are confirming that, if your abstract is accepted, you will prepare and submit a poster for the deadlines provided, and will register for and will attend the conference on both days.

Deadline:

Deadline 17th January 2024 12 Noon UK time, or on receipt of first 120 abstracts, whichever is earlier (there will no extensions)

The presenting author's name must be in bold and underlined on the abstract

Please provide the (work) email address of the presenting author

Requirements

The abstract must be submitted by the presenting author

The presenting author of the abstract must register for the conference and must be eligible for conference attendance (please check before submission).

Abstracts must be written in English.

The person submitting the abstract must be the person with whom we should correspond about the abstract. This person is responsible for liaison with co-authors.

Submitters will be notified by email if their abstract has been accepted. Please check all inboxes.

All abstracts should be fully checked before submission. We reserve the right to correct spelling / typographical errors in the abstracts.

All abstracts will be published as part of a supplement in an academic journal – by submitting your abstract, you are agreeing to this.

Accepted abstracts will either be selected for 15 minute platform presentations, 5 minute flash poster oral presentations, or posters.

If your abstract is accepted and you do not provide your finalised poster in accordance with any deadlines specified, we reserve the right to remove your abstract / poster from the event.

Encore abstracts are not accepted.
