

# Paediatric Dysphagia Videofluoroscopy Swallow Study Course

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## Who Should Attend:

This 2 day course is aimed at dysphagia-trained speech and language therapists who are interested in further developing their skills in paediatric videofluoroscopy swallow studies.

## Structure of Course:

The 2 days will consist of presentations and workshops in the following areas:

- Referral to paediatric VFSS
- Role of MDT
- VFSS procedure
- Analysis, interpretation and management

It is anticipated that delegates attending the course will have had some previous experience and/or training in analysing studies.

## Timetable:

**Day 1:** The first day will consist of a range of practical presentations including the normal and abnormal swallow, assessment profiles, developing competencies and application of a severity scoring tool. Additionally there will be presentations by members of the Radiology team and a Respiratory Paediatrician.

**Day 2:** Themed analysis and interpretation workshops run by specialist SLTs in the areas of ENT/head and neck; cardiorespiratory, cleft/craniofacial, neurology and general surgery/gastro. All delegates will have the opportunity to attend each workshop.
