





Downloading References to EndNote from Electronic Resources (Mac)

The databases listed below can be accessed through the ICH Library Website at <https://www.ucl.ac.uk/child-health/support-services/library/databases>

Database name	Instructions for direct export or saving references to import
CINAHL (EBSCOhost)	<p>From the search results screen:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Click on the folder  to the right of each reference you wish to keep.• Click on  Folder (at the top of the screen) to view the references you have kept.• Select all items in your folder by checking the Select / deselect all box.• Click on Export.• From the next page, select Direct Export in RIS Format (e.g. CITAVI, EasyBib, EndNote, ProCite, Reference Manager, Zotero) and click on Save.• The file (called Delivery) will save to Downloads.• Drag the file from Downloads to the EndNote icon on your Mac's Dock.


Cochrane Library

From the search results screen:

- Mark the references you wish to save and click on **Export Selected** (at the top of the results list).
- Leave **Export type** as **PC**.
- Select **Citation And Abstract** from the **File type** drop-down menu.
- Click on **Export Citation**.
- The file (called citation-export) will save to Downloads.
- Drag the file from Downloads to the EndNote icon on your Mac's Dock.
- Select **Cochrane Library (Wiley)** from the **Choose A Filter** window and click on **Choose**.

Explore (UCL library catalogue)

From the search results screen:

- Click on the star symbol  next to any references that you want to send to Endnote.
- Click on **e-shelf**.
- Tick the boxes next to the references to re-select them.
- Select **Push to RIS (EndNote or RefMan)** from the drop-down menu above the list of references.
- Click on **Go**.
- Click on **OK** in the pop-up box headed **Import to Citation Manager**.
- The file (called Primo_RIS_Exports.ris) will save to Downloads.
- Drag the file from Downloads to the EndNote icon on your Mac's Dock.

Google Scholar

- Access Google Scholar from scholar.google.co.uk
- Carry out a search for the subject of your choice.

To import a single reference

- Click on the **double quotes** symbol beneath the reference.
- Click on the **EndNote** link at the bottom of the pop-up window
- Choose to **Open** the file.
- The file (called scholar.enw) will save to Downloads.
- Drag the file from Downloads to the EndNote icon on your Mac's Dock

To import multiple references

- Sign in to Google
- Click in the **star** symbols beneath the references that you wish to send to EndNote
- Click on **My Library**
- **Tick the checkbox** above the list of references to select them all
- Then, click on the **down arrow** and select **EndNote**
- Choose to **Open** the file.
- The file (called scholar.enw) will save to Downloads.
- Drag the file from Downloads to the EndNote icon on your Mac's Dock

NICE Healthcare Databases

(AMED, BNI,
EMBASE,
Health Business
Elite, HMIC,
PubMed,
PsycINFO)

From the search results screen:

- Mark the references you wish to save.
- Click on **Add to Saved** above the list of results.
- Scroll up to the **Current search strategy** box
- Tick the checkbox to the left of **Saved Results**
- Click on **Export Options** column
- From the Output Format drop-down menu, select **RIS**.
- Click on **Save File**.
- The file will save to Downloads.
- Drag the file from Downloads to the EndNote icon on your Mac's Dock

OvidSP Databases

(including
AMED,
EMBASE,
HMIC,
MEDLINE,
PsycINFO)

From the search results screen:

- Mark the references you wish to save.
- At the top of the screen, click on **Export**.
- Select **EndNote** from the drop-down **Export To** menu.
- Choose which fields you want to export and then click on **Export Citation(s)**.
- Choose to **Open** the file with **EndNote** and click on **OK**.
- The file will save to **Downloads**
- Drag the file from Downloads to the **EndNote** icon on your Mac's **Dock**.
- You may then select your EndNote library from the window that appears.

Proquest Databases

From the search results screen:

- Mark the references you wish to save.
- Above the search results, click on **Save**.
- Select **RIS (works with EndNote, Citavi, etc.)** from the drop-down menu.
- Click on **Continue**.
- The file will save to **Downloads**
- Drag the file from Downloads to the **EndNote** icon on your Mac's **Dock**.
- You may then select your EndNote library from the window that appears.

PubMed

From the search results screen:

- Mark the relevant records.
- Click on the **Send to** menu.
- Select **Citation manager** and click on **Create File**.
- The file will save to **Downloads** with the name **citations.nbib**.
- Drag the file from Downloads to the **EndNote** icon on your Mac's **Dock**.
- You may then select your EndNote library from the window that appears.

ScienceDirect journals

(e.g. Lancet)

From the table of contents:

- Tick the box(es) next to the article(s) you want to export.
- Click on **Export** (above the list of articles).
- Under **Export file**, select **RIS (for EndNote, Reference Manager, ProCite)**
- Under **Content**, select how much of the record you wish to import.
- Click on **Export**.
- The file will save to **Downloads**
- Drag the file from Downloads to the **EndNote** icon on your Mac's **Dock**.
- You may then select your EndNote library from the window that appears.

SCOPUS

From the search results screen:

- Tick the boxes next to the articles you want to export.
- From the menu near the top of the screen, click on **Export**.
- Select **RIS format** as the export format. Choose which fields to output, and click on **Export**.
- The file will save to **Downloads**
- Drag the file from Downloads to the **EndNote** icon on your Mac's **Dock**.
- You may then select your EndNote library from the window that appears.

SFX

In the SFX@UCL window (in any database):

- At the bottom of the SFX window, click on **Go** next to **Download Citation to Reference Manager / EndNote**.
- The file will save to **Downloads**
- Drag the file from Downloads to the **EndNote** icon on your Mac's **Dock**.
- You may then select your EndNote library from the window that appears.

Web of Science

From the search results screen:

- Tick the boxes next to the articles you want to export.
- Click on the arrow to the right of **Save to EndNote online** (above the list of search results).
- Select **Save to EndNote desktop**.
- Use the drop-down menu to select the record content, then click on **Send**.
- The file will save to **Downloads** with the name **savedrecs.ciw**.
- Drag the file from Downloads to the **EndNote** icon on your Mac's **Dock**.
- You may then select your EndNote library from the window that appears.
