

PubMed



PubMed is a freely available version of Medline produced by the National Library of Medicine in the USA. It is a bibliographic database that contains journal citations and abstracts for biomedical literature from around the world. It contains over 27,000,000 records and is updated daily.

How to access PubMed

PubMed is freely available via the Internet at <u>www.pubmed.gov</u>.

UCL staff and students should access PubMed via the Library's website at https://www.ucl.ac.uk/child-

<u>health/support-services/library</u> in order to get UCL's findit@UCL buttons, which link to all the full-text articles to which UCL provides access.

GOSH staff can access these UCL links, and the UCL full-text articles, from computers in the GOS-ICH Library.

How to search PubMed

- 1. Define your search concepts and any limits you wish to apply. E.g. if you were looking for randomised controlled trials carried out since 2000 on analgesia in children undergoing a tonsillectomy the search concepts and limits would be:
 - Search concepts: analgesia, tonsillectomy
 - Limits: randomised controlled trials, children, 2000-, human, English
- 2. Enter the concepts in the search box as follows: **analgesia tonsillectomy** You can simply type in your concepts separated by a space, then click on **Search**.

Filters

Use the filters to the left of the PubMed screen to apply limits to your search. Click on **Show additional filters** to view and select more options. **NB**: To restrict your search to a certain age group, it is usually better to use the filters, rather than typing 'child' or 'paediatrics' into the search box.

Display Settings

Use these menus to change the display of your results list, for example to view abstracts, or to change the sort order.

Send to

Use this menu to save or export your results:

- To save a file to EndNote, select Citation manager
- To save results temporarily within PubMed, as you search, select Clipboard
- To save results permanently within PubMed, select Collections



Advanced

Click on Advanced to view your Search History.

Click on Add next to the searches you wish to combine. Then choose AND or OR, from the drop-down menu, to combine your selected searches in the Search Builder.

Click on **My NCBI** to view your saved searches and results. Click on the name of the search or collection to view the results in PubMed.
