



The power of attention

	OK Child Behaviour	NOT OK Child Behaviour
Parental Attention (Increased Behaviour)	Praise Catch your child being good	Criticism trap Telling off Arguments
No Parental Attention (Decreases Behaviour)	"Let sleeping dogs lie"	Active ignore









Descriptive commentary (1)

Follow

Follow the child's lead

Notice

Emphasise desired behaviour

Describe

Describe behaviour and emotions

Volume

Raise or lower the intensity or frequency of positive attention





Descriptive commentary (2)

Silent question, verbal answer: What is the Child Doing Now?










