

Welcome to the 4th edition of the BENCHISTA Newsletter. We are very grateful for your continued support and participation in the study.

In this issue, we provide a brief update on cancer registries participation status, number of cases submitted and upcoming communication and dissemination opportunities.

Highlights

The BENCHISTA Project has current participation from 68 Population-Based Cancer Registries (PBCRs) from 24 European countries, Australia, Brazil, Japan, and Canada.

As of 24th April 2023, 10,500 cases have been received (>90% of expected total) and are undergoing quality control.

3 cancer registries have completed the "Accession Document" to join and contribute to the project.

The **4**th **Annual Meeting of the European Society for Paediatric Oncology** will take place on the 08-12 May 2023 in Valencia, Spain.

A joint session organized with CCI-Europe has been scheduled on **Friday 12th May 2023 from 8am to 9am** (Room 8). In this session we will discuss about the progress of the BENCHISTA project, results to date and future perspectives for the project.

This represents a great opportunity to interact with different European Clinical Trials Groups, oncologists, SIOPE groups, parents and survivors' representatives, funders, and other stakeholders.

The First in-person Meeting of the BENCHISTA Project Working Group (PWG) will be held on the **19th-20th June 2023** - Aula Magna at the Fondazione IRCCS Istituto Nazionale dei Tumori (INT) in Milan, Italy.

The meeting aims to gather the members of the PWG, tumourspecific clinical experts, parent and patient representatives and other key stakeholders to hear and discuss the first results of the population-based data analyses, the strengths, and limitations of their interpretation, and to plan further tumour-specific analyses according to availability of the non-stage prognostic factors and other optional variables.
