

Government Defeat in Lords on Welfare Reform Bill

On 11/01/2012 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Welfare Reform Bill: To replace the 12-month time limit for contributory employment support claims by those in the work-related activity group with a prescribed period of at least 2 years.

This was defeat number 27 in the parliamentary session.
