

Government Defeat in Lords on Crime (Overseas Production Orders) Bill [HL]

Monday 22/10/2018

On 22/10/2018 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Crime (Overseas Production Orders) Bill [HL]: To specify that, in any overseas exchange of electronic data under the bill, assurances must be obtained that the death penalty will not be applied in respect of any offence in which data provided from the UK contributed to securing the conviction.

This was defeat number 34 in the parliamentary session.
