

Government Defeat in Lords on Trade Bill

On 21/01/2019 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Trade Bill: To move, as an amendment to the motion that the house resolves into committee, to require the government to present to both houses proposals for the UK to make international trade agreements before the bill can move to report stage.

This was defeat number 42 in the parliamentary session.
