

Government Defeat in Lords on Prisoners (Disclosure of Information About Victims) Bill

On 01/07/2020 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Prisoners (Disclosure of Information About Victims) Bill: To require that the Parole Board provide ongoing information about the applications of murderers for parole to the families of their victims, where the Board does not know where or how the victim's remains were disposed of.

This was defeat number 19 in the parliamentary session.
