

Government Defeat in Lords on Parliamentary Constituencies Bill

On 08/10/2020 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Parliamentary Constituencies Bill: To expand the length of time between Boundary Commission reports after the dates set out in the bill from every eight to every ten years.

This was defeat number 35 in the parliamentary session.
