

Government Defeat in Lords on Parliamentary Constituencies Bill

On 08/10/2020 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Parliamentary Constituencies Bill: To require the Secretary of State to lay proposals before parliament which would encourage the inclusion of 16- and 17-year olds on the electoral registers for the purposes of boundary reviews within a year of the Act coming into force.

This was defeat number 38 in the parliamentary session.
