

# Government Defeat in Lords on Universal Credit (Transitional Provisions) (Claimants previously entitled to a severe disability premium) Amendment Regulations 2021

On 11/02/2021 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Universal Credit (Transitional Provisions) (Claimants previously entitled to a severe disability premium) Amendment Regulations 2021: To regret that the regulations do not fully compensate claimants who move from Severe Disability Premium legacy benefits to Universal Credit and to call on the government to extend the COVID-19 Universal Credit uplift to legacy benefits (non-fatal motion).

This was defeat number 87 in the parliamentary session.
