

# Government Defeat in Lords on Health and Care Bill

Tuesday 01/03/2022

On 01/03/2022 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Health and Care Bill: To provide that conflict of interest rules applicable to integrated care boards also apply to committees or sub-committees of boards that have commissioning functions.

This was defeat number 66 in the parliamentary session.
