

# Government Defeat in Lords on Immigration (Restrictions on Employment and Residential Accommodation) (Prescribed Requirements and Codes of Practice) and Licensing Act 2003 (Personal and Premises Licences) (Forms), Etc., Regulations 2022

Tuesday 07/06/2022

On 07/06/2022 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Immigration (Restrictions on Employment and Residential Accommodation) (Prescribed Requirements and Codes of Practice) and Licensing Act 2003 (Personal and Premises Licences) (Forms), Etc., Regulations 2022: To regret that the regulations do not provide an option for physical proof of status to be used in right to work and rent checks for all migrants, and regret that the changes are being made without an impact assessment (non-fatal motion).

This was defeat number 1 in the parliamentary session.
