

Government Defeat in Lords on Procurement Bill [HL]

On 28/11/2022 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Procurement Bill [HL]: To require that a national procurement policy statement include among its strategic priorities meeting climate change targets and Public Services (Social Value) Act 2012 requirements, promoting supplier innovation, and minimising waste of public money.

This was defeat number 10 in the parliamentary session.
