

# Government Defeat in Lords on Procurement Bill [HL]

Wednesday 30/11/2022

On 30/11/2022 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Procurement Bill [HL]: To insert a clause requiring the Secretary of State to publish a timeline for removing surveillance equipment from the government supply chain, where there is evidence of supplier involvement in modern slavery, genocide or crimes against humanity.

This was defeat number 12 in the parliamentary session.
