On 28/06/2022 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Pharmacy (Responsible Pharmacists, Superintendent Pharmacists etc.) Order 2022: To regret that the regulations do not make provisions about workforce and budgetary pressures on the community pharmacy sector (non-fatal motion).

This was defeat number 2 in the parliamentary session.
