

# Government Defeat in Lords on UK Infrastructure Bank Bill [HL]

On 04/07/2022 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the UK Infrastructure Bank Bill [HL]: To amend the definition of infrastructure to include the circular economy and nature-based solutions related to the utilities set out in the bill.

This was defeat number 3 in the parliamentary session.
