

Government Defeat in Lords on UK Infrastructure Bank Bill [HL]

On 04/07/2022 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the UK Infrastructure Bank Bill [HL]: To require that the new UK Infrastructure Bank must have regard to the public interest in targeting investment in a way that reduces economic disparities between regions of the UK, and improves productivity, pay, jobs and living standards.

This was defeat number 4 in the parliamentary session.
