

Government Defeat in Lords on Slavery and Human Trafficking (Definition of Victim) Regulations 2022

Wednesday 20/07/2022

On 20/07/2022 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Slavery and Human Trafficking (Definition of Victim) Regulations 2022: To regret that the regulations have not been subject to consultation and that they may narrow the definitions of victims of slavery and trafficking so as to make access to protection and support for victims harder (non-fatal motion).

This was defeat number 5 in the parliamentary session.
