

Government Defeat in Lords on Product Security and Telecommunications Infrastructure Bill

On 12/10/2022 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Product Security and Telecommunications Infrastructure Bill: To insert a clause to require an independent review of the impact of the electronic communications code and Telecommunications Infrastructure (Leasehold Property) Act 2021 on high-speed broadband and other telecommunications infrastructure.

This was defeat number 6 in the parliamentary session.
