

# Government Defeat in Lords on Social Housing (Regulation) Bill [HL]

## Tuesday 18/10/2022

On 18/10/2022 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Social Housing (Regulation) Bill [HL]: To insert a clause requiring the government to publish a strategy on reducing energy demand for social housing properties, including low-carbon heat targets and an energy efficiency target for all social housing properties by 2030.

This was defeat number 7 in the parliamentary session.
