

# Government Defeat in Lords on Procurement Bill [HL]

On 28/11/2022 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Procurement Bill [HL]: To include the NHS in the bill's definition of a public authority.

This was defeat number 8 in the parliamentary session.
