

Government Defeat in Lords on Procurement Bill [HL]

On 28/11/2022 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Procurement Bill [HL]: To require that before publishing a national procurement policy statement, a Minister must have regard to principles of promoting the public good, value for money, transparency, integrity, fair treatment of suppliers and non-discrimination.

This was defeat number 9 in the parliamentary session.
