

Government Defeat in Lords on Social Fund Winter Fuel Payment Regulations 2024

On 11/9/2024 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Social Fund Winter Fuel Payment Regulations 2024: To regret that changes to the winter fuel payment will leave pensioners worse off in winter, that a decision was made prioritise pay rises for unionised public sector professionals, and the lack of transparency over policy during the election.

This was defeat number 1 in the parliamentary session.
