

# Government Defeat in Lords on Passenger Railway Services (Public Ownership) Bill

Wednesday 6/11/2024

On 6/11/2024 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Passenger Railway Services (Public Ownership) Bill: To insert a clause placing a duty on the SoS, when taking any actions under the provisions of the Act, to have regard to the improvement of the performance of passenger railways services.

This was defeat number 4 in the parliamentary session.
