

Government Defeat in Lords on Passenger Railway Services (Public Ownership) Bill

Wednesday 6/11/2024

On 6/11/2024 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Passenger Railway Services (Public Ownership) Bill: To insert a clause requiring the SoS to terminate the existing franchise agreements in order of worst-to-best performance via break clause only once satisfied that the provision of services by a public sector company would improve the existing service.

This was defeat number 5 in the parliamentary session.
