## Democracy in the UK after Brexit

### Advisory Board Minutes

#### Meeting 3: 02/09/21, 10:00-11:30

1. Dr Alan Renwick (PI) welcomed Advisory Board (AB) members to the meeting. He provided a brief summary of the project's progress, including the ongoing analysis of the first population survey and the recruitment of Assembly members. A brief discussion followed on the importance of retaining the respondents once their participation has been confirmed.
2. A discussion of the Assembly's first two weekends followed. Topics included: revisions to the existing list of features of democracy; the ideological and geographical diversity of speakers at the Assembly; and areas of the democratic system that AB members felt had been underrepresented in the existing plans.
3. A discussion of the Assembly's third, fourth and weekends followed. Topics included: possible alterations to the focus of the weekend devoted to norms; possibly adopting a less institution-centric approach; and the degree of flexibility to be provided in the agenda to allow Assembly members to shape the Assembly.
4. Charlotte Kincaid (the Constitution Unit's Impact Research Fellow) and Tom Fieldhouse (the Constitution Unit's Research Fellow and Network Coordinator) presented the project's impact strategy, and asked AB members for feedback and about connecting existing networks to the project.
5. Dr Renwick thanked the AB members for their time and contributions, noted the date of the next AB meeting, and encouraged further ideas and feedback to be submitted by email.
